The **PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE PROGRAM (SUPERVISION)** has been developed to provide group supervision in the tradition of Solution Oriented, Ericksonian hypnosis.

The **PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE PROGRAM (SUPERVISION)** is open to fully registered psychologists who have completed a minimum of **PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE PROGRAM (HYPNOSIS)**, Year 1, or equivalent. Registered psychologists who have completed equivalent training are advised to speak to Rachel beforehand to ensure that it meets their professional development needs.

The **PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE PROGRAM (SUPERVISION)** contains ten 1.5 hour group supervision meetings. Meetings will cover a range of topics in Solution Oriented, Ericksonian hypnosis. They will also provide a forum to discuss ethical issues, build confidence with Ericksonian techniques (including levitation, catalepsy, multilevel communication and ideomotor signalling), as well as provide a forum for case discussion.

The first meeting for the year will be a forum to get to know one another, as well as determine each participant's supervisory goals. Remaining meetings will be structured to meet each participant's goals.

To ensure that each participant's supervisory goals are met, up to five places will be available per year. Individual supervision is also available.

WHEN AND WHERE

The **PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE PROGRAM (SUPERVISION)** meetings will be held on the 4th Thursday of every month, March to December each year. All meetings will be held in our 2nd floor training room, 142 Auburn Road, Hawthorn.

WHAT TO BRING

We will provide all course notes, materials and handouts. You will need to bring a pen or pencil.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT POINTS
